#### Grading System:

All assignments will be graded using the point system (ex. 18/20 means 18 of out 20 points were earned for the assignment)

Grades will be calculated using the following percentages:

Major (tests, quizzes, projects, performance tasks, etc.) - 50%

Minor (classwork, spiral checks, study guides etc.) - 25%

Daily (homework) - 15%

**Final** - 10% (Final will be given over content from the last nine-weeks of the semester & placed as one grade in the final exam category.)

\*\*\* Students must maintain a 70 average in order to remain in good academic standing. Students whose averages fall below 70 at the end of a grading period will be placed on academic probation.

## Agendas:

Agendas are required and may be purchased in the Media Center for \$5. ## Homework:

Homework is for your benefit, providing practice you will need to become proficient in math. Homework is due the next school day, unless told otherwise. Each homework assignment will be graded on completion and should be corrected as it is reviewed the next day. Homework not turned in on time or incomplete will not be given full credit. Work must be shown in order to be considered complete.

## Make-up Work:

If you miss class, it is your responsibility to get, complete, and turn in all activities and assignments missed. You will find these items in the folders, labeled by class periods, located on the wall below the whiteboard. All work (including tests) must be made up within five (5) school days unless you are out for an extended period of time. The BMS grading policy states: a zero will be recorded until the make-up work is completed. It is a good idea to select a "buddy" in the class that you can call to get your make-up work the day you miss it.

### Tutoring:

This time will be utilized to help students who are struggling, so the need to stay after school may not be necessary. If staying after school, students should be picked up in the **front of the building** at 3:30. You will need to bring in a note from home or have your parent or guardian contact me to let me know that it is o.k. for you to stay for tutoring. I must have notification in order for you to stay. Please make sure that you are picked up promptly at 3:30 Failure to be picked up promptly may result in not being able to stay for tutoring on future occasions.

I **DO NOT** give extra credit on an individual basis. When extra credit is given, it will be given to the entire class and it will be the responsibility of the individual student to take advantage of this opportunity. There will be no exceptions in this policy.
